a. Follow Up – 4-way stop at 9th Street & Lighthouse Lane, and 3rd Ave & Boardwalk Ave

ACTION: PW to provide red curb as noted in study exhibit.

b. Review the marking – Abrams Dr & Imjin Pkwy (West intersection)

ACTION: PW to provide yellow striping as noted in study exhibit.

c. Add cross walk – Abrams Dr

ACTION: Developer designing crosswalk into Phase 4 Improvements. Anticipated approval for construction in Q2 2022.

d. Install 25mph speed limit – Abrams Dr

ACTION: Developer has ordered signs and will coordinate with City for placement.

- e. Speed study – Marina Heights
ACTION: Exhibits for enforcement will be provided to PD. Speed Limit sign placement will be coordinate with the Developer.

- f. Install guard rail – Imjin Pkwy between 2nd Ave & Highway 1
ACTION: Preliminary study completed. Additional analysis will be considered in Local Roadway Safety Plan for future funding opportunities.

- g. Red Curb – Carmel & Vaughn Avenues
ACTION: PW has completed the work request. No further action required.
