**ACTION: Design is underway with the Project expected for construction in FY 22/23. PW will confirm that the crossing beacon has an audible alert system for the visually impaired.**
- b. Keep Left Sign - Marina Heights Dr and California Ave  
**ACTION: PW will install R4-7A sign & stop bar with a review of further improvements/modifications.**

- c. School Related - California Ave and Carmel Ave  
**ACTION: TAMC (A. Green) and MPUSD (PK Diffenbaugh) in support of collaborating with City for short-term (e.g. temp. bulb outs) and long-term (e.g. roundabout) solutions and grant opportunities. PW will review and resolve maintenance issues and coordinate with TAMC for interim improvements.**
  - d. Over 3 Tons Trucks - Marina Dr & Legion Way  
**ACTION: PD will contact MPE for truck traffic restrictions.**
  - e. Stop Sign - Marina Dr and Starfish Dr  
**ACTION: PW will review if a yield sign in lieu of a stop sign is allowable.**
  - f. Motorcycle Noise Pollution - Cardoza Ave, Abdy Way, and Healy Ave  
**ACTION: No action required.**
