- a. Airport Parking Lots and Roadway speedbumps (mainly Bldg. 527)
ACTION: Joby (SanGiovanni) in discussion w/ PD (Anderson) for possible enforcement. PW to work with PD and Joby for further site improvements.
- b. Red Curb - Zanetta Dr. and Reindollar Ave.
ACTION: PD request (Russo); PW will install 25 linear feet of red curb and check with MST if the bus stop fronting the percolation basin is still active.
- c. Sidewalk Painting for Visually Impaired Residents

Marina Cycle and Skate - Reservation Rd.
Prince Liquor - Carmel Ave.

ACTION: PW to match existing width for Reservation Rd with dashed white striping. Carmel Avenue will need legal counsel for right of entry and next steps.

d. Stop Sign - 4th Ave. and Telegraph Blvd.

ACTION: Traffic volumes do not meet warrants for all way stop. No further action.

e. Pedestrian Safety - Intersection of Carmel Ave. and California Ave.

ACTION: Updates:

- Meeting between TAMC, Recreational Department of the City, Marina Vista and Crumpton elementary schools to coordinate for “Walking Bus” idea.
- Working on temporary bulb-out design for traffic calming.
- Moving forward with sign updates provided in previous meeting.
