

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-154

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARINA
CANVASSING THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018, GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION IN
THE CITY OF MARINA

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2018-39, called and provided for a General Municipal Election to be consolidated with the statewide election held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, for the election of one person to the office of Mayor for a full term of four (4) years and of two members of the City Council for the full term of four years as required by the provisions of the laws of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, On November 6, 2018, the City of Marina held a consolidated General Municipal Election for the election of the Mayor, two City Council Members; and

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2018, the City of Marina held a consolidated General Municipal Election for the passage of Measure N, Measure P and Measure V; and

WHEREAS, prior to the elected officials taking office, the vote must be canvassed and certified by the Elections Office of the County of Monterey. This canvas and certification has now been completed ("Exhibit A").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that it is found and determined:

1. That the total number of registered voters in the City of Marina was 10,582 and;
2. That the total number of votes cast at said election was 6,711 and that the following persons received the number of votes for the following offices:

A. For the Office of Mayor, Two-Year Term:

B. For the Office of Council Member, two (2) Four-Year Terms:

3. That the person receiving the highest number of votes cast at said election for the Office of Mayor was Bruce Carlos Delgado and is hereby declared to be elected to said office for a four (4) year term; and
4. That two persons receiving the highest number of votes cast at said election for the four (4) year term office of City Council Members were: Lisa Berkley and, Adam Urrutia and said persons are hereby declared to be elected for a four (4) year term to said offices; and

5. **Measure N**, To sustain and improve city services such as fire, police, road repairs & maintenance, shall the ordinance increasing the rate of the City of Marina's existing transactions & use ("sales") tax from 1% to 1.5% estimated to generate approximately \$4,890,000 annually as compared with \$3,260,000 for the current tax and extending the expiration date for the tax to March 31, 2034 be adopted?

6. **Measure P**, To sustain and improve city services such as fire, police, road repairs & maintenance, shall the ordinance increasing the rate of the City of Marina's existing transient occupancy tax ("hotel tax") from 12% to 14% estimated to generate approximately \$3,733,000 annually as compared with \$3,200,000 for the current tax and to continue until repealed by the voters be adopted?

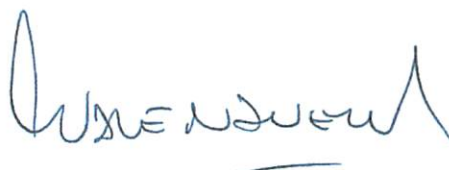

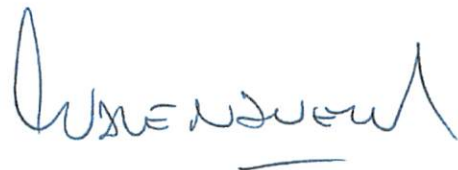

**CITY COUNCIL CONSIDER ADOPTING RESOLUTION NO. 2018-,
CANVASSING THE NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GENERAL MUNICIPAL
ELECTION OF THE CITY OF MARINA**

REQUEST:

It is requested that the City Council consider:

1. Adopting Resolution No. 2018-, canvassing the November 6, 2018 General Municipal Election of the City of Marina and Measure N, Measure P and Measure V.

BACKGROUND:

On November 6, 2018, the City of Marina held a consolidated General Municipal Election for the election of the Mayor, two City Council Members

ANALYSIS:

Prior to the elected officials taking office, the vote must be canvassed and certified by the Elections Office of the County of Monterey. This canvas and certification has now been completed (“**EXHIBIT A**”).

The total number of registered voters in the City of Marina was 10,582; and the total number of votes cast was 6,711.

A recap of the votes is listed below.

Based upon the canvas and certification of the election, the person receiving the highest number of votes cast at said election for the Office of Mayor was Mr. Bruce Carlos Delgado. Mr. Delgado is hereby declared to be elected to said office for a four (4) year term.

The two persons receiving the highest number of votes cast at said election for the four (4) year term Office of City Council Members were Lisa Berkley and Adam Urrutia and are hereby declared to be elected for a four (4) year term.

Measure N, amended the Marina Municipal Code increasing the rate of the City of Marina's existing transactions & use ("sales") tax from 1% to 1.5% and extending the expiration date for the tax to March 31, 2034 be adopted.

Measure P, increasing the rate of the City of Marina's existing transient occupancy tax ("hotel tax") from 12% to 14% and to continue until repealed by the voters be adopted.

Measure V, permitting operation in the City of Marina of certain cannabis businesses and establishing a business license tax for such businesses at rates not to exceed 5% of gross receipts, to continue until repealed by the voters.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Based upon historical data, the permanent increase of the transient occupancy tax (hotel tax) rate from twelve percent to fourteen percent will generate approximately \$533,000 annually of General Fund revenue to provide municipal services.

Based upon historical data, the extended City transaction and use (sales) tax will generate approximately \$1.63 million annually or \$16.3 million over the ten-year period of General Fund revenue to provide municipal services.

Measure V potentially generating \$40,000 to \$200,000 annually to the General Fund revenue to provide municipal services.

CONCLUSION:

This request is submitted for City Council consideration and possible action.
