WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of June 20, 2023, the City Council of the City of Marina adopted Resolution No. 2023-66, receiving a presentation on the City's Pavement Management Program for Fiscal Years 23/24, 24/25 and 25/26. As part of the staff presentation, the City's annual street resurfacing project was introduced with Senate Bill 1 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account funds, Measure X and General Fund funding for roadway maintenance.

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of May 7, 2024, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2024-35, approving advertising and call for bids for the 2024 Citywide Slurry Seal Project.

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2024, three (3) sealed bids were received, opened, and were publicly inperson. Following is the tabulation of bids received: VSS International (\$342,000), Graham Contractors, Inc. (\$375,988), and Pavement Coatings Company (\$706,570.20), and;

WHEREAS, Grand Total Bid is the sum of Bas Bid (bid items 1-9) and Bid Additive Alternate (bid items (A1-A10). The bid additive is for the Dunes Community Facilities District (CFD) Slurry Sealing of a portion of Phase 1C. Using this information, VSS International, Inc. has been determined by staff to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, and;

WHEREAS, following is the estimated expenditure to execute the project to completion: Construction Costs (\$342,000), Contingency (\$51,300), Construction Management & Administration (\$115,000), Construction Design Support (\$14,214), totaling \$522,514, and;

WHEREAS, should the Council approved this request, there are sufficient funds in the Project CIP budget and Dunes CFD budget. The approved CIP project funding amount for Fiscal Year 23/24 is \$10,328,408.39 in the City's CIP Project Account XAPR1801 for Phase 1 (Reconstruction) and Phase 2 (Slurry). The approved Dunes CFD budget for FY 23/24 (CC Reso. 2023-74) included \$345,740 for roadway maintenance to fund the Bid Additive scope of work in the Dunes CFD Account 252-Roadway Maintenance, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Marina determined the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines per Article 19, Section 15301, Class 1 because the project is consisting of repair and maintenance of existing public structures and facilities with no expansion of use.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Marina does hereby:
