**REQUIRED CERTIFICATIONS:** All construction sites requiring a SWPPP / WDID # require staff on-site with specific proven skills, knowledge and abilities (*SKA*). One way to demonstrate the required SKA is to obtain necessary certifications (*i.e. CPESC, CESSWI, QSD and/or QSP*) provided by EnviroCert International and/or CASQA.
