REQUIRED CERTIFICATIONS: All construction sites requiring a SWPPP/WDID # coverage require staff on-site with specific proven skills, knowledge and abilities (SKA). One way to demonstrate the required SKA is to obtain necessary certifications (i.e. CPESC, CESSWI, QSD and/or QSP) provided by EnviroCert International and/or CASQA.
