General Plan Amendment: Make recommendations and prepare reports regarding a proposed amendment to the City General Plan.

Zoning Ordinance text/map Amendment Planning Commission and City Council consideration of an amendment to the zoning ordinance text or zoning map.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR GENERAL PLAN OR ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT:

- Required processing fee.
- Required processing deposit for environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- Planning Application Cover Page.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR MAP CHANGES:

- Environmental Information Form.
- □ 8 copies of the Site Plan (drawn to scale). Include the following information:
 - □ Applicant's name, address, and phone number.
 - □ Vicinity map showing an overview of the project location in Marina.
 - □ North Arrow and scale.
 - □ Address and assessor parcel number(s) of the project site.
 - Property lines and dimensions of the project site and surrounding properties.
 - Name and boundaries of adjacent streets.
 - Access to the site.
 - Location of existing and proposed building and structures, including signs.
