ARMED ROBBERY OF MARINA GAS STATION

On August 21, 2010 at 21:59 PM, Marina Police Officers were dispatched to a report of an armed robbery that occurred at the Valero Gas Station located at 416 Reservation Road. Officers responded and contacted the victim who stated a male suspect had robbed the store at gunpoint. The suspect was able to obtain a small amount of money and then fled the area.

During the investigation, officers spoke to a witness that saw the suspect fleeing on foot to a vehicle waiting on California Avenue. The suspect then left the area in the vehicle and eluded capture. A partial license plate for the suspect vehicle was obtained that is similar to California license plate #6HEW95_.

The suspect was described as a male, unknown race, wearing a black ski mask, black hooded sweatshirt, and black sweatpants. He was described as being 5'7" – 5'9" tall and of average build and having dark colored hair. He was armed with an unknown caliber semi-automatic handgun.

The suspect vehicle was described as being a black, possibly Honda, 4-door vehicle. The vehicle was in clean condition and seemed to sit low to the ground. The windows on the vehicle were tinted. The vehicle was driven away by another unknown person with the suspect as a passenger.
